He has extensive experience in pricing and ratemaking projects, predictive analytics analysis, independent reserves review, Due Diligence and M&A assignments, Solvency II and IFRS 17 implementation, reinsurance valuations, Capital Management, and Solvency Capital Requirements review. Nicola is also frequently engaged in providing independent expert or expert witness support, particularly regarding the transfer of insurance portfolios and winding-up procedures.
